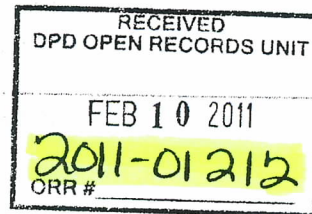

I am doing graduate research for my doctorate at Southern Methodist University. I have previously requested certain citation records; the Municipal Courts were helpful, but their data only goes back to 2004.

I am aware that, as of Terrell Bolton's tenure as Dallas Police Chief, DPD had a numeric-based scoring system that assessed officer performance based on several factors. I recall an article in the Dallas Morning News explaining that one factor was number of speeding tickets written by each officer. Bolton reduced the points that a speeding ticket gave an officer to encourage more speed ticketing.

Do these performance records exist in electronic form? How far do they go back? What would be the charges for obtaining all such records for all officers every on staff, subtracting records only available on paper from this request?
